AURORA (V.O.)

Tell me about something that broke you, that completely changed who you are, that made you crumble.

FAY

Oh, you know I hate these questions.

AURORA (V.O.)

Just answer. Please.

FAY

Well, I was sad when John cheated. That completely changed my life.

AURORA (V.O.)

In what way?

FAY

He was the one that did me wrong. Yet I lost everything. He kept the dog, he kept the apartment. He was fine. And I was...me. You know, you envision this life for yourself, and you're happy, and then something happens to snatch that future from you and you become...dust.

Pause. FAY is clearly frustrated.

AURORA (V.O.)

What did you do to fix yourself, knit your bones back together, to heal the bruises on your psyche?

FAY

I dunno. I pouted. I felt bad for myself. I let myself cry. I think that's a hard thing to do sometimes, to cry for yourself, but it's good for you. Crying can be good for you.
